

- 13 new CCTV cameras have been installed in the junior, senior wing and at the guard room at the places which are prone to accident making a total count of 63 cameras in the school campus. These are monitored during school hours by school staff so that an immediate action may be taken in case of any untoward incident.
- Evacuation plans are put up on all floors and evacuation mock drills are conducted at times.
- Regular workshops are conducted on POCSO Act to educate children so that they don't fall prey of sexual abuse.





Academic Scholarships are conferred upon to the meritorious students who have scored 90% or above in aggregate in class X CBSE Examination (session 2018-19). Also top three scorers of class XI were given academic scholarship.

- Sports Scholarship was awarded to five students who had performed well CBSE tournaments at both National and State level.
- Introduction to Open Door's Diagnostic Assessment Program (V-VIII) To improve the conceptual understanding of students in Science and Mathematics the Open Door's Diagnostic Assessment Program was introduced from July 2019. It aims at developing the habit of 'learning by understanding'. These assessments help school teachers to make improvements in student's understanding through remediation and repeated assessments. Through a series of enjoyable and high-quality assessments and constant feedback, students are able to gain an in depth understanding.





AUTISM AWARENESS WEEK
